Gonzaga Middle School is an innovative independent middle school for students from underserved families living in Northeast downtown and North End Winnipeg neighbourhoods that opened in September 2016. It uses the unique middle school educational framework and best practices from Jesuit Nativity model schools, adapting them to the communities served in Winnipeg. The school offers small class sizes, enrichment opportunities, summer programming and a Graduate Support Program for Gonzaga Middle School graduates through secondary and post-secondary studies. GMS offers staff very competitive remuneration and a strong benefit program.

Opportunity:

Gonzaga Middle School is seeking a middle year's teacher. In collaboration with the rest of the educational team, the successful candidate will teach a variety of subjects. They will participate in school activities and demonstrate a commitment to all aspects of the school mission. Qualifications include a Bachelor's Degree in Education as well as proven experience in and passion for middle year's education. Proven success working in an inner-city school setting would be an asset.

This role is to cover a maternity leave. Depending on the successful candidate's availability, there is the potential for the role to start prior to 28 April, 2025.

Description:

GMS teachers are an integral part of the school community. They are directly responsible for the students' spiritual, moral, intellectual, emotional, social and physical development. The success of each GMS student hinges upon the determination and excellence of each faculty member. GMS teachers demonstrate a commitment to academic excellence and professional development and the best ideals of the Catholic faith. They also demonstrate openness to Indigenous perspectives and GMS' commitment to reconciliation. Teachers will accompany learners engaging them to reflect on their experience, beliefs, and values in ways that respect the multicultural and multi-faith background of learners. Teachers recognize that GMS asks them to approach their work as a vocation and make substantial contributions of their time and talents in the service of GMS students. The goal of a Gonzaga teacher will be to develop students who demonstrate character, leadership and service to others. Teachers will work closely with staff, volunteers, families and members of the community to ensure the overall success of the students.
