- ♦ Applicants must be under 18 years of age
- ♦ Create a piece of visual art on one 8.5x11-inch (letter size) piece of paper.
- ♦ Work on your artistic creations at home or come out to our public creation of art between **10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. on August 27, 2016** in the gymnasium of Gonzaga Middle School. Art materials will be provided and a **barbeque for art participants their family members and interested community members will be offered** between 12:00-1:00 pm.
- ♦ Embody and reflect any aspect of your own, your family or any other aspect of the history of residential schools and reconciliation in Canada, or the contribution by Indigenous Peoples to Canada's History.
- ♦ Sign a permission/release form, (by a parent or guardian). Forms will be available for download from the Gonzaga Middle School website.
